- 3.1 Demonstrate leadership in advocating for human rights, social, economic and environmental justice - This student demonstrated leadership this week by advocating for client's rights and justice. Two examples of this are as follows: 1) a client missed a therapy appointment and their injection appointment, did not have any emergency contacts listed, releases of information signed for any of their family members, and did not have any case manager listed in their chart, so after discussing in supervision these findings, this student contacted Chattanooga Police Department to perform a wellness check on the client. 2) another client missed a few therapy appointments and a doctor appointment, this student sent the client a letter regarding his missed therapy appointment, called to follow up multiple times, but did not receive any response. This student reached out to this client's case manager and asked if they could drive by to check on him. The case manager reached the client and was able to work with this student in the coordination of rescheduling the client's missed therapy and doctor appointments.
- 3.1 Demonstrate leadership in advocating for human rights, social, economic and environmental justice I was able to demonstrate leadership by training the new intern on how to perform a wellness check. By conducting the wellness check on a specific client, this allowed us to learn that this client had been hospitalized. Another incident where I demonstrated these skill this week was when a different client reached out to me via text in a crisis type situation. I notified his care coordinator that he was in distress and needed her to either call or drive by to check on him. I also provided the client with the crisis response services telephone number if he needed it.
