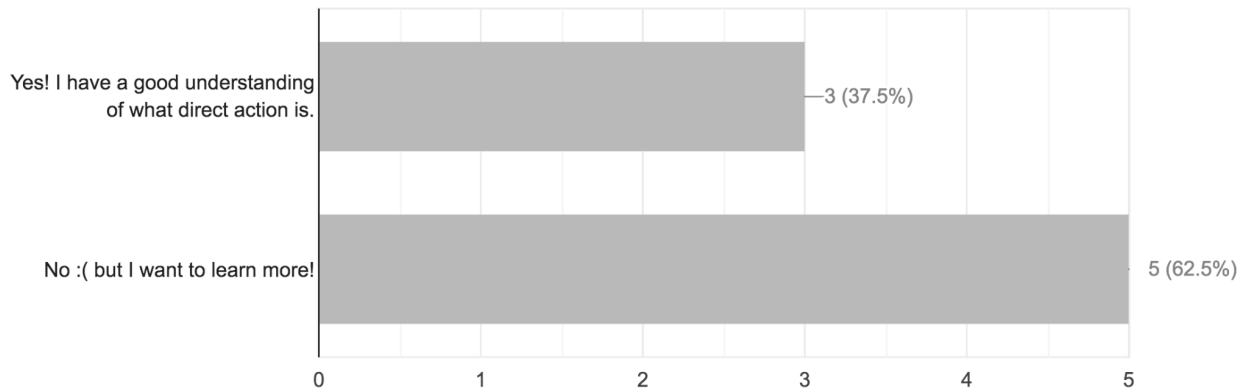

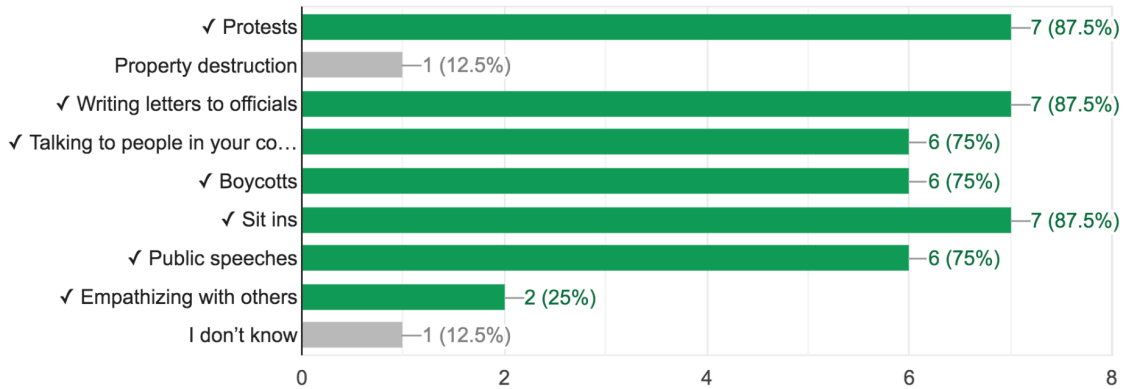
Do you know what direct action is?

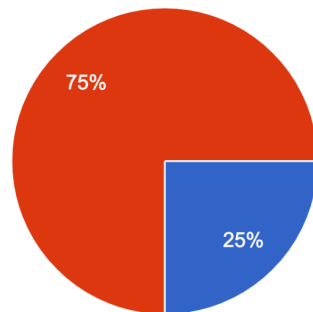
What do you think direct action looks like?
