CM Martinez arrived at Parkridge East Hospital and spoke with Vienna **Taylor**, the hospital social worker. She stated that BMO tested positive for barbiturates and benzos at the time of the birth. BMO is breastfeeding and is doing well bonding with VC. BMO lives with her 4 year old son Hank, MGMO Lisa **Taylor**, and MSGFA. BFA of VC is Allen **Taylor** DOB **10/5720**. They have been togeather for 2 years. BMO has a history of anxiety, depression, and bipolar. BMO said the benzo was from her taking a clonipin that she had left over from an old prescription. BMO said she to the clonipin a few days prior to the birth because she could not sleep.

CM arrived in BMO's room. Present in the room was BMO, BFA, and VC. CM spoke with BMO. She stated the following;

- She lives with her mother and step-father Lisa and Jeff Holliday and her other son Hank OBE DOB 2000000
- Hank is not in school or daycare
- · She is a stay at home mom
- The last job she had was in 2017 at a bar
- · She left that due to no longer wanting to be in that environment
- She has never been married
- · She has mental health issues with depression, anxiety, and bipolar
- · See has seen a psychiatrist and therapist
- · She went to the Relationship Therapy Center and TriState Psychiatric
- · She has had CBT and repetitive eye therapy
- · She feels that the therapy works for her
- She stopped treatment when she became pregnant
- She was on multiple medications to treat her mental health including abilofy, clonipin, and hydroxicine
- · She felt that the medication would hurt her baby while she was pregnant
- · She did not consult her doctor before stopping her medication
- Her OBGYN later prescribed her Zoloft and hydroxicine
- · During her pregnancy she still struggled with anxiety and depression
- · She mainly had a hard time sleeping
- She also quick therapy due to feeling better
- · She took one clonipin the night before she delivered because she could not sleep
- · The clonipin prescription was not current
- · Her OBGYN also prescribed her medication for her headaches caused by high blood pressure
- · She is planning to continue breastfeeding and feels that it helps wit her depression
- · After a year of breastfeeding she plans to go back to the therapy and get back on medication for her bipolar and depression
- "I need medication"
- She does not have anymore clonipin left and thinks she still has the empty bottle prescribed to her
- She was given percesets at the hospital in October due to a sprained ankle

- · No mental health history

CM reviewed safe sleep with both parents. CM left the room. A few minutes later CM received a phone call from BMO. BMO stated that she is planning on going to stay with BFA at his house after she is released to have him help with VC. CM stated that if he was going to be a caregiver that he would have to complete a drug screen as well. CM walked back over and gave BMO a drug screen form for BFA due to him having left the hospital. CM left the room again. A few minutes later CM received another call from BMO. BMO stated that she called BFA and told him about the drug screen and that he said that he would not take it and that she and VC could no longer stay at his house. BMO seemed very upset. CM then returned to the room and spoke with BMO. BMO stated at first she did not know why BFA would not take the drug screen. CM stated that she has been with him for two years and has a child with him and that it would be very unlikely if she did not know why he would not take the drug screen. BMO then stated to BMO that the safety plan would have to be amended. BMO agreed to not allow BFA unsupervised with BFA. CM explained that if BMO would work with the department and complete a drug screen and substance abuse assessment that he that safety plan could be changed at that time. BMO understood.

Safety Assessment;

CM observed BMO with VC. CM observed that BMO was very bonded with VC and seemed to have adequate parenting knowledge. CM does have concerns due to BMO's mental health and her taking the clonipin that was a prescription that was out of date. CM also has concerns due to the BFA's pill use. BMO has been very cooperative with the department thus far. CM will continue to work with BMO and reach back out to BFA to offer drug and alcohol assessment and treatment. CM will continue to assess for safety.
