Practice reflection and self-regulation to manage personal values and maintain professionalism in practice situations.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Debrief with task supervisor to discuss what happened within the sessions and to process emotions, feelings, thoughts, and suggestions that came up before, during, or after the sessions. - Be intentional about self-awareness - Leave biases out of sessions - Work to maintain composure and facial expressions when unexpected things are said in sessions - Remove myself from the situation if appropriate or necessary
