Independent Living Group: Job Application & Interview Questions: 11/06/19

Objectives:	The objective is to introduce the group to what is needed to successfully fill out a job application and interview in order to get a job.
Review Homework:	Review homework of creating a budget for a shopping trip.
Activity:	Patients will be handed cards with random nouns. Patients will choose two random nouns and invent a product. Patients will make up facts about the product in order to convince the group that they have the most desirable product.
Discussion:	What was needed to convince the group that a certain product was best? What can we learn about applying and interviewing for jobs from this activity? What do you need to do in order to convince employers that you are the best choice for the job?
Job Applications:	A standard job application will be distributed, and the typical information needed on a job application will be discussed.
Interview Questions:	The patients will review commonly asked interview questions and pointers on answering them.
Home Work:	Patients will be asked to write down an answer for at least one interview question.
