Independent Living Group: Interview Etiquette: 11/13/19

Objective: The objective is to educate group on wise behaviors to engage in before, during, and after a job interview.

Review Homework: Review activity where patients had to write down one thought-out answer to the interview question.

Activity: The patients will draw a number out of a box that correlates with the handout. The patient will then demonstrate the opposite of what the number says for the group in a pseudo job interview. The group will guess which number the patient has. Then the patient will demonstrate or discuss the correct behavior.
