Independent Living Group:

Job Application & Interview Questions: 11/06/19

Objectives:	Information was provided regarding what is needed in order to fill out a job application and interview in order to get a job.
Review Homework:	No one remembered to bring back the homework. Most likely this was the case because the group had missed a week. However, patients were able to recall some of what was covered during the previous independent living group.
Activity:	The patients seemed to respond well to the activity. They appeared engaged and contributed well.
