PROPOSAL SUMMARY

Bethel Bible Village seeks to administer ethical, Christian interventions to children and families experiencing crisis. Their hope is that whoever passes through their doors will receive a blessing and feel inspired to live productive Christian lives. In order to ensure their ability to practice their methods of intervention they require financial support from generous organizations and individuals seeking to aid in the rehabilitation programs. Money awarded from this grant will assist our teen mothers emerge autonomous.

NARRATIVE

Bethel Bible Village was founded in 1954 with six boys who were living on the streets due to an incarcerated father and a mother living in a facility. Flyod Hipp, a prison minister, saw the need for the children to be taken care of while the family was in crisis; thus began what is now known as Bethel Bible Village. As of 2018, there are four distinct programs that are offered: Back on Track for boys with emotional and behavioral challenges, Life Steps Program for girls and boys 5-17, Promise First Step Program for pregnant teens and teen moms in crisis, and Next Step designed to help families in crisis transition to independence. Social workers, teachers, and other on-site staff are involved in the lives of children and adults who lean on Bethel for support; their mission includes helping
