Under demonstration of my field instructor, I am continuing to learn several different methods of communication with each client as well as which proves to be the most effective. Each case is different, but I've found that regardless of the case, more often than not, if I am able to initiate empathy and communicate in a respectful way, the client is generally receptive and cooperative. We have encountered several different situations, some more extreme or difficult than others, and I am continuing to learn the best way to react and communicate with clients during each one. 7: Under supervision from my field instructor, I have been able to identify areas of strength and areas of challenge throughout the interviewing process with clients. I am learning the best ways to communicate when certain issues arise or when a client is particularly hostile or emotional. We can never be fully prepared for how a client might react, but I've realized that by implementing certain strategies, most interviews are able to flow somewhat smoothly. I have assisted my instructor in selecting mutually agreed on intervention goals based on the presenting concerns and needs of the client. It has been especially encouraging to see the intervention strategies implemented and carried out successfully by our clients. 8: I have been able to implement and assess progress towards goal attainment by a few clients under guidance from my field instructor. I have assisted my instructor as she advocates on our clients behalf; in the courtroom and in family and child team meeting. I hope to continue to learn the various ways in which we are able to advocate for our clients as well as which methods produce the most successful outcomes. I hope to participate in more family and child team meetings in order to better understand the inter-professional collaboration of my field instructor and her supervisor. 9: My instructor and I continue to evaluate interventions with clients and continually monitor their progress. If necessary, we implement additional strategies and continually follow up as much as we feel necessary. Despite the case overload my instructor consistently has, she never fails to stay up to date with each of her clients and see her families regularly until she is able to close a case. I hope to become comfortable enough to develop future recommendations for favorable outcome strategies for goal attainment with clients on my own.
