Referral Reason: An anonymous referral was made regarding LD. The referral cited abandonment, environmental neglect, and educational neglect as the primary concerns.

Client Strengths / Protective Factors: LD consistently demonstrates resilience and is attending school

ACE Score/ Trauma information: LD has been separated from her mother for prolonged periods of time throughout her entire life; LD has been exposed to consistent drug use by both her mother and her father and is a child victim of severe domestic violence

Risk Factors: Substance abuse, Inadequate supervision, Inadequate living conditions

Background Information: LD has been separated on and off from her mother since birth. When response was met, LD was not enrolled in school and was living with her mother in inadequate conditions. LD's mother showed signs of using methamphetamine. The mother refused a drug screening. The other couple listed on the referral have cared for LD on and off since she was born. They were able to pass a drug screening but their home was not environmentally appropriate.

Treatment Goals:

1. Enroll the mother in a drug treatment program
2. Enroll the child in school and arrange for her to receive in-home counseling
3. For the child to live in a safe and loving environment

What is the desired outcome from the client, family, & referral source?

For the child to remain with her mother in a safe and loving environment

What interventions have been already attempted? What were the outcomes?

Enroll the child in school and set up in-home counseling: we were able to confirm the child attended her first day of school and contacted Helen Ross McNabb to set up in-home counseling. After refusing to take a drug screen during our initial home visit, we set up a drug screening appointment for the mother at the CPS office. The mother called ten minutes after the appointment was scheduled and reported that she had to cancel because she was on her way to the emergency room due to an infected tooth.

Reason for Staffing:

A second attempt to administer a drug screening for the mother was unsuccessful; the conditions of both the mother and the couple willing to care for the child are not environmentally appropriate.
