

In addition to the regular statement of need and demographic information, the EPP Committee will only assess cases that meet the minimum standard of qualification.

We will only submit for cases that are \$3,000 or less OR where an attorney is involved and has arranged a negotiated settlement of \$3,000 or less for the client's case at the outcome of their discretion as legal representatives.

Each "yes" is 1 "point" with 5 required points to be considered for funding. We will not ask for evidence of their statements. All questions will be asked during intake and if a potential client meets 5 of the below criteria, a statement of need can be written for committee review.

1. Have you received a detainer summons for court?
2. Are you currently employed or do you have a job lined up in the near future? Does someone in your household?
3. Do you have other forms of income (Child support, food stamps, SSI, unemployment, pension)?
4. Do you have minor children in the home?
5. Are your elderly, disabled?
6. **Are you a first responder?**
7. Do you only have one income in your home?
8. Have you lived in your residence longer than one year?
9. Have you been attempting to make partial payments on rent?
10. Do you have a landlord willing to work with you?
