SW visited PT at The Lantern facility. PT was asleep in bed at the time of visit. SW observed PT's mouth opening every second/two seconds while sleeping. Will visit PRN.

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SW visited PT at the Lantern facility. PT was awake in her chair facing the window at the time of visit. PT's daughter was present, and son was on the phone visiting PT at the time of visit. PT reported not feeling as good, and PT's daughter reported that she falls in the mornings, but is never hurt; a mat is placed at the bottom of the bed for falls. PT communicated, but was not fluid and confused. PT reported loving the food. While SW was heading out of the facility, PT's daughter asked SW to not address visits with "from hospice" to not raise concern with her mother. PT's daughter reported that PT's son is also not agreeable to hospice being present, and does not want PT to die.

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SW visited PT at the Lantern facility. PT was sitting outside at the back of the facility at the time of visit. SW attempted conversation, and SW observed that PT did not respond to questions or very limited responses. SW observed PT to be happy and in good spirits. PT kissed SW hand twice at the end of the visit.

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SW visited PT at the Lantern facility. PT was sleeping in bed at the time of visit. PT's brother was present at the time of visit. PT's brother reported that today the PT was sleeping a lot more, and this happens every two or so days of more sleep than normal. PT's brother reported that PT has been using an oxygen tank since 4/5 days ago. PT's brother has mentioned the decline in PT. PT's brother reported that she is now on a full liquid diet, but struggles with liquids as well. SW asked if any supplies were needed, and PT's brother reported that nothing was needed at this time.

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SW visited PT at the Lantern facility. SW was sitting on the couch in the lobby at the time of visit. SW engaged in conversation, and observed that PT was able to talk but was not intelligible.

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SW visited PT at LCC. PT was lying in bed watching television at the time of visit. PT reported that she had to get rid of her chair since it cost \$100 a month and was out of budget. SW engaged in conversation about family of PT. PT reported not feeling like eating. SW observed potato chips and peanut butter crackers in a to-go box being eaten by PT, and PT reported not really having a taste for potato chips either. PT reported that one of her daughters was supposed to come bring her chicken wings. PT reported never sleeping well. During conversation with PT, PT commented that she often thinks when will God take me, and being ready, but reported being in a positive mood and mindset.

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SW visited PT at LCC. PT was sitting in a chair next to bed at the time of visit. PT reported having a fall, which has been causing knee pain. PT reported being on water pills and a breathing treatment. PT reported to SW that her toes and right hip hurt when she sits for long periods of time, and also having allergies. PT reported having a harder time talking because of teeth, and commented that she had thought someone was going to come clean her teeth but no one has come as of yet. PT reported that she wants healing, but if God wants to take her she will be okay. SW engaged in conversation with PT about her past career, church, and bingo wins. PT reported having to use the bathroom at the time of visit. SW asked a staff member for assistance. At the end of the visit, SW asked staff members again to assist PT who needed to be cleaned after having an accident.
