

TENNESSEE LOW INCOME HOME ENERGY ASSISTANCE PROGRAM



WHAT IS LIHEAP?

LIHEAP is a Federally Funded program that provides financial assistance to eligible low-income households to meet energy needs. LIHEAP funding can help pay for electric, gas, propane, coal, oil, kerosene, and wood.

AM I ELIGIBLE?

Eligibility is based upon household income. See chart for maximum income levels. You must be a Tennessee resident to receive assistance.

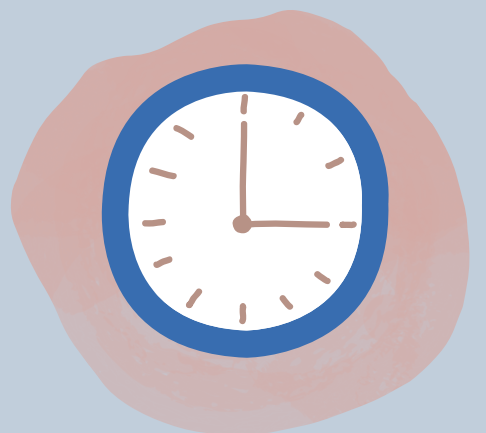


HOW TO APPLY?

In order to receive LIHEAP benefits, you must submit a LIHEAP application along with a household member record, an income detail sheet for each household member 18 and older, social security verification, income documentation, and annual energy consumption documentation.

HOW OFTEN CAN I APPLY?

You may apply for LIHEAP once every 12 months.
