Tenn. Code Ann. S49-6-1301 et seq. states that the state of Tennessee is not required to have any type of sexual education until a county's teenage pregnancy rate surpasses a certain percentage. This needs to change.

Hispanic and Black teenage pregnancy rates are more than doubled the rates of their White counterparts.




