Charge Nurse Dawn said patient has not been re-evaluated. The mother did not agree to the plan to send patient home. Dr. Culbertson asked CM to follow up with Youth Villages about patient needing a re-assessment.

CM Klosterman called Youth Villages (866-791-9225). Elizabeth said she will call back.

RN Christy said patient had new cuts so they used a metal detector to find a razor blade she had hidden in her underpants. She took the razor blade, and said patient is now very upset.

RN Dawn said she heard from Youth Villages that they are on their way to Children's Hospital Emergency Department (CHED).

Dr. Culbertson asked about progress with Youth Villages. CM said she heard from RN Dawn that they are on their way.

Micah from Youth Villages arrived and talked with the family. CM Klosterman and Intern Varela met with Ms. Micah and with patient's mother. Intern Varela assisted with some interpretation when [redacted] indicated she did not understand. [redacted] said she wants her daughter to go to a residential treatment facility, not back to Park Ridge Valley. She has been to Valley four times. [redacted] said if patient had to go to acute inpatient treatment first before going to residential treatment, she preferred she went to a facility in Nashville instead of Knoxville. Ms. Micah said [redacted] could stay there while arrangements were made for her to go to a residential facility. Staff at the acute facility could make the referral. To make sure the referral was made, patient's therapist Mackie Robinson could also be working on gaining admission for [redacted] at a residential facility. [redacted] agreed. Ms. Micah said she will start working on the referral to the acute facility in Nashville.

CM Klosterman updated Dr. Culbertson.

Ms. Micah said [redacted] told her that [redacted] picks at her breasts until she bleeds and scabs. She said [redacted] wants her breasts "gone."

RN Christy said at [redacted] request, she checked [redacted] to make sure she was not mutilating her breasts. She said there was only one small spot. She said [redacted] was upset but allowed her to do the brief exam. RN Christy said something seems very wrong emotionally with [redacted], and asked if she has an abuse history. CM said she suspects she might but has not heard anything definitive.
